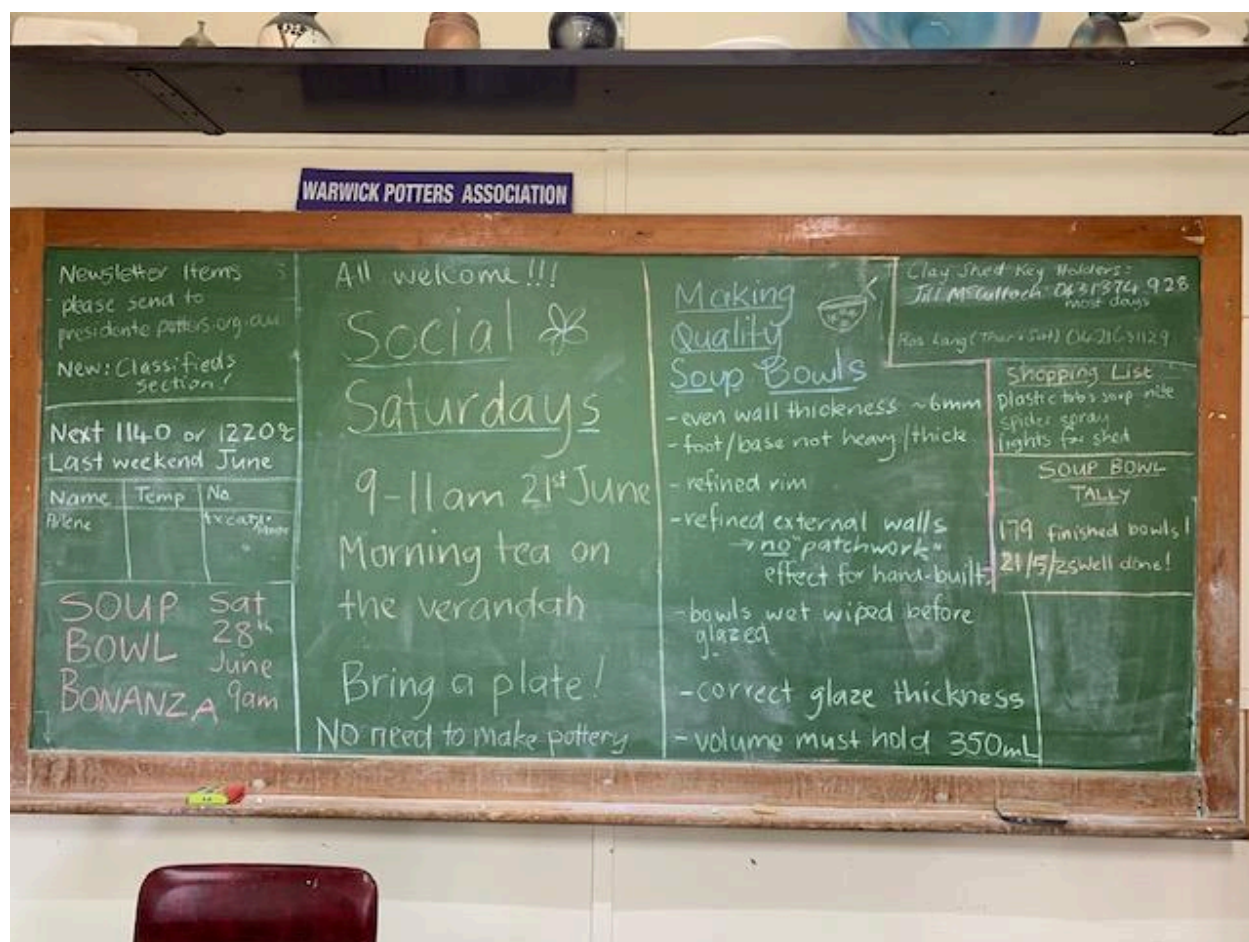

The word Hippopotomonstrosequipediaphobia is the fear of long words. Have a go at saying this one !!!

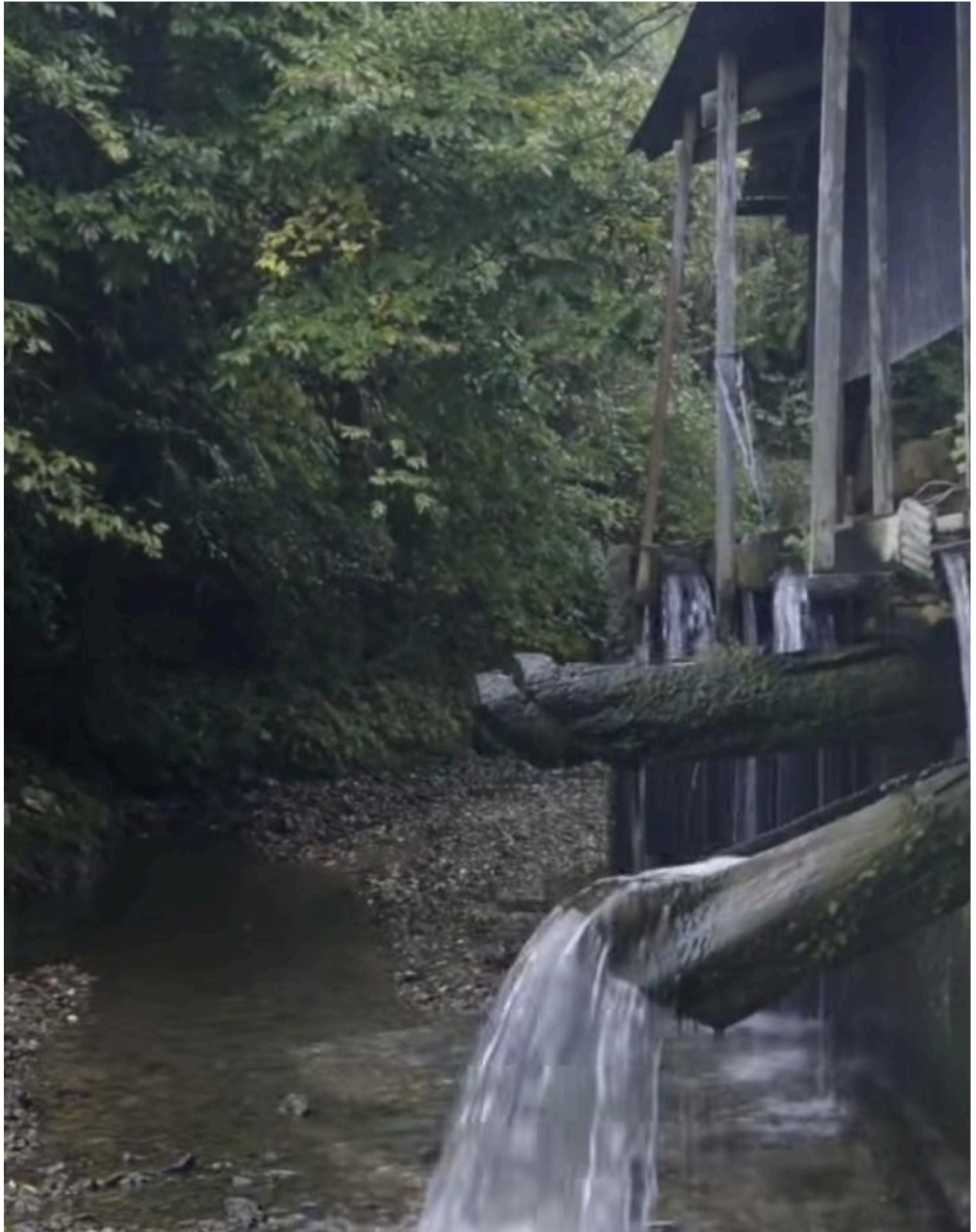
The official name for a "hashtag" is "octothorpe".
